## AN OVERVIEW

Scholarships at Kings' Education are awarded to students who demonstrate an exceptional talent in a particular area. Our scholars hold an important leadership position in the student community at Kings' School Al Barsha. They are role models who demonstrate how rewarding dedication to their chosen fields can be. Our scholars must demonstrate an exemplary attitude towards their learning, possess great respect for others, and uphold the high standards expected at Kings'.

Awards come as a percentage of money, which is taken off the school fees each term.

The maximum award for a scholarship is 25%. There are three types of scholarship available at secondary level:

**ACADEMIC** | **ART** | **SPORT**

It is not possible for a student to hold more than one scholarship, e.g. Art and Academic, due to the level of commitment required from scholars in each area. The scholarship programmes all provide personalised provision and pathways for our students to foster and enhance their unique talents.





## ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP

Students applying for an academic scholarship, must demonstrate academic prowess across a broad range of subject areas. We do not offer scholarships for single subjects, however, in some circumstances, students with exceptional talents in one area may be considered for an award.

All students applying for year 7 to year 10 for an academic scholarship will be required to complete

an entrance exam and undertake an interview with the Headteacher.

Successful students will participate in the Kings' academic scholarship programme (see application guide). Students applying for academic scholarships for Sixth Form will require predicted GCSE grades of A\*- A or 9-8 in at least 8 subjects.



## ART SCHOLARSHIP

Kings' has a large and well-equipped Arts faculty, which includes Drama, Music, Photography, and Visual Arts. If your son or daughter is a talented artist in any field, they may wish to apply for an Arts scholarship.

To apply for an Arts scholarship you will need to fill out an application form. Your son or daughter will then be invited to the school for an interview

to discuss their specialist area following their initial admissions tests.

The interview may include a performance, review of previous work, and presentation of a portfolio of work. An overview of the Arts scholarship application can be found on the school website.





## SPORT SCHOLARSHIP

Sport is a huge part of school life at Kings' and we are dedicated to ensuring that all students enjoy and participate in a wide range of sports.

If your child loves sports and is an exceptionally talented, determined and enthusiastic sports person, they may want to apply for a sports scholarship. Candidates may be 'all-rounders' or be particularly talented in one sport.

To apply for a sport scholarship you will need to complete an application form.

All applicants will be invited to an assessment day between November and December during which they will participate in sessions to test their strength, speed, stamina, and agility; approach to competitive sport scenarios and matchplay. There are three levels of sporting scholars to reflect our students' abilities.
